ASSIGNMENT OF CIRCUIT COURT
JUDGE JOSE M. RODRIGUEZ IN
FAMILY DIVISION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 10-19, the **HONORABLE JOSE M. RODRIGUEZ**, was temporarily re-assigned from the Family Division (Section FC 47) to the Circuit Civil Division (Section CA 24); and

WHEREAS, such temporary re-assignment has ended; therefore, Judge Rodriguez will resume his assignment in the Family Division;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rule 2.215, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. The **HONORABLE JOSE M. RODRIGUEZ** will resume his assignment in the Family Division (Section FC 47), located at the Lawson E. Thomas Courthouse Center.
2. Further, in addition to his assignment in the Family Division, Judge Rodriguez will continue to handle certain matters in the Circuit Civil Division, specifically:
 - A. Foreclosure Calendars;
 - B. Calendars of judges who are absent for an extended period of time; and
 - C. Other matters as may be assigned by the Administrative Judge of the Circuit Civil Division.

This Administrative Order shall take effect on Monday, June 6, 2011 and shall remain in full force and effect until the judicial rotation occurs in January, 2012.
