**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 12-21 A4
(Amending AO No. 12-21, as amended)**

**IN RE: AMENDING DESIGNATION
OF JUDICIAL OFFICERS AND
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR
MOTIONS TO EXCEED FEE LIMITS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 12-21, as amended, the undersigned designated certain judicial officers to hear and determine motions to exceed the fee limits filed by court appointed counsel, in accordance with section 27.5304(12)(b) ("Motions"); and

WHEREAS, as set forth in said Administrative Order, as amended, Motions to exceed fee limits filed in the Circuit Court Juvenile Delinquency and Dependency, Termination of Parental Rights and Judicial Bypass Division were to be heard and determined by the Honorable Michael Hanzman and the Honorable Angelica Zayas, respectively, on a quarterly rotational basis beginning July 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Judge Hanzman and Judge Zayas have provided invaluable services in connection with such hearings; but are unavailable to continue to serve in this capacity; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Orlando A. Prescott and the Honorable Maria I. Sampedro-Iglesia are available to preside over the herein referenced Motions commencing on or about January 2, 2014, on a quarterly rotational basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, Administrative Order No. 12-21, as amended, is hereby amended in the following particulars:

1. For motions to exceed the fee limits filed in the Juvenile Delinquency and Dependency, Termination of Parental Rights and Judicial Bypass Division:
 - a. The Honorable Orlando A. Prescott will hear and determine said Motions for the first quarter beginning on or about January 2, 2014

through March 21, 2014, and the third quarter beginning on or about July 1, 2014 through September 30, 2014.

- b. The Honorable Maria I. Sampedro-Iglesia will hear and determine said Motions for the second quarter beginning on or about April 1, 2014 through June 30, 2014, and the fourth quarter beginning on or about October 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014.

2. Said quarterly rotation by the Judges designated herein shall continue until further order of the Court.

Except as herein amended, all other provisions set forth in Administrative Order No. 12-21, as amended, are and shall remain in full force and effect until further order of the Court.

This Administrative Order shall become effective immediately upon exception.
