**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 15-01**

**IN RE: ESTABLISHMENT OF
SECTION 34 IN THE CIRCUIT CIVIL
DIVISION OF THE ELEVENTH
JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, due to the volume of new cases continually filed and pending in Section 42 in the Circuit Civil Division of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida ("Division"), to include asbestos cases and cases generally associated with the Division, it has been determined that the establishment of another section within the Division is necessary in furtherance of judicial economy and administrative efficiency; and

WHEREAS, upon the establishment of a new section, the Clerk of the Courts will transfer all of the pending cases in Section 42 that are generally associated with the Division to the new section, excluding the asbestos cases;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rule 2.215 of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. The Clerk of the Court is hereby authorized and directed to immediately take whatever steps are necessary to establish Section 34 in the Circuit Civil Division of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida. In any event, Section 34 shall be established no later than close of business on Friday, March 20, 2015.
2. Upon the establishment of Section 34, the Clerk will transfer all of the pending cases in Section 42 that are generally associated with the Division, excluding the asbestos cases, to Section 34.
3. Due to the establishment of Section 34, the Clerk shall notify all attorneys of record in any pending matters assigned to Section 42, that are generally associated with the Division, excluding asbestos cases, that such matters have been reassigned to Section 34.

This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
