**IN RE: ESTABLISHMENT OF
SECTION 35 IN THE CIRCUIT CIVIL
DIVISION OF THE ELEVENTH
JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, due to the volume of new cases continually filed and pending in Section 40 in the Circuit Civil Division of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida ("Division"), to include complex business litigation cases and foreclosure cases, it has been determined that the establishment of another section within the Division is necessary in furtherance of judicial economy and administrative efficiency; and

WHEREAS, upon the establishment of a new section, the Clerk of the Courts will transfer all of the pending foreclosure cases in Section 40 to the new section;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rule 2.215 of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. The Clerk of the Court is hereby authorized and directed to immediately take whatever steps are necessary to establish Section 35 in the Circuit Civil Division of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida. In any event, Section 35 shall be established no later than close of business on Friday, March 20, 2015.
2. Upon the establishment of Section 35, the Clerk will transfer all of the pending foreclosure cases in Section 40 to Section 35.
3. Due to the establishment of Section 35, the Clerk shall notify all attorneys of record in any pending foreclosure matters assigned to Section 40, that such matters have been reassigned to Section 35.

This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
