ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 80-7

PURSUANT TO the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, the following procedures shall be followed as to the transportation of defendants from the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services:

1. Upon receipt of the disposition summary form from the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services requesting the Court to return a defendant for a commitment status hearing, the Department of Corrections of Dade County shall forthwith take custody of the defendant from the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services and return the defendant to the Dade County Jail.
2. Upon return to the Dade County Jail the defendant's case shall be placed on the Judge's next alias capias calendar for a hearing on the issues contained in the disposition summary form.
3. If the Court orders an evaluation after the defendant has been returned to court, the Forensic Unit of Jackson Memorial Hospital shall be appointed as the initial expert witness to evaluate and diagnose the defendant.
4. All other Administrative Orders entered In Re: Transportation of Defendants for Commitment Status Hearings are hereby rescinded and held for naught and this Order shall serve in its stead.
