ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 80-23

PURSUANT TO the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, effective January 1, 1981, and until further order of the Court, the following Departments are continued in the Family Division of the Circuit Court. Methods of assignment and procedures for administrative control will be adhered to as indicated below:

FAMILY JUVENILE DEPARTMENT

There shall be five (5) Sections within the Family Juvenile Department which shall consist of four (4) Trial Sections and one (1) Sounding Section. The Administrative Judge is hereby authorized to assign Judges to these Sections on a rotating basis by administrative memorandums.

FAMILY CIVIL DEPARTMENT

The Family Civil Department is hereby attached to the General Jurisdiction Division of the Circuit Court. Assignment of Judges to Sections within this department are set forth in Administrative Order No. 80-22, in Case No. 80-1.

The Family Civil Department shall maintain its original identity as established and shall be attached to the General Jurisdiction Division of the Circuit Court only for the purpose of administrative control.
