**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

**IN RE: AMENDING THE  
DESIGNATION OF CERTAIN  
JUDICIAL OFFICER AND  
DESIGNATING QUALIFIED ELECTOR  
OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA  
TO SERVE AS AN ALTERNATE  
MEMBER OF THE MIAMI-DADE  
COUNTY, FLORIDA CANVASSING  
BOARD FOR THE MARCH 26, 2019  
PINECREST SPECIAL ELECTION**

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**WHEREAS**, pursuant to §102.141(1), Florida Statutes, the membership of the Miami-Dade County, Florida Canvassing Board shall be composed of the Supervisor of Elections; a County Court Judge, who shall act as Chair; and a member of the Board of County Commissioners ("County Canvassing Board"); and

**WHEREAS**, additionally, §102.141(e)1, Florida Statutes, requires the Chief Judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located to appoint a County Court Judge as an Alternate Member of the County Canvassing Board; and

**WHEREAS**, as provided in section 102.141(1)(d), Florida Statutes, if a substitute member or alternate member cannot be appointed as specified hereinabove, or in the event of a vacancy in such office, the chief judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located shall appoint as a substitute member or alternate member a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed; and

**WHEREAS**, accordingly, the Supervisor of Elections for Miami-Dade County, Florida requested that the undersigned appoint certain judicial officers to serve in such capacities for the March 26, 2019 Pinecrest Special Election; and

**WHEREAS**, the appointed Canvassing Board members shall convene the next day on March 27, 2019 in connection with the March 26, 2019 Pinecrest Special Election; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 19-59, the **HONORABLE TANYA BRINKLEY** was appointed to serve as Alternate Member the Canvassing Board for the March 26, 2019 Pinecrest Special Election; however, the Honorable Tanya Brinkley is unavailable to serve in the capacity as an Alternate Member; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the **HONORABLE VICTORIA FERRER**, as the Chair, and **QUALIFIED ELECTOR GABRIELA JIMENEZ SALOMON** as the Alternate Member pursuant to Administrative Order 19-59, the undersigned was requested by the Supervisor of Elections to appoint an additional Alternate member to ensure there is a fully functioning Canvassing Board ; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida under Rule 2.215, Rules of Judicial Administration, and §102.141, Florida Statutes, the following judicial officer and qualified electors of Miami-Dade County, Florida are appointed to serve on the Miami-Dade County, Florida Canvassing Board for the March 26, 2019 Pinecrest Special Election as follows:

1. Judge Victoria Ferrer will continue to serve as Chairperson.
2. Qualified Elector Gabriela Jimenez Salomon will continue to serve as the Alternate Member.
3. Qualified Elector Sonia Perez shall serve as the Alternate Member.
4. All such Judge and the Qualified Electors are hereby authorized to attend all meetings convened for the County Canvassing Board, as required, and are hereby authorized to sign all documents pertaining to the subject Election.

Except as amended herein, all terms and conditions set forth in Administrative Order No. 18-59, as amended, remain in full force and effect.
