**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 21-03 A1
(Amending AO No. 21-03)**

**IN RE: AMENDMENT TO
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 21-03,
REGARDING CASE FILINGS IN
SECTIONS HI 04 AND HI 05 IN THE
COUNTY CIVIL DIVISION OF THE
ELEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF
FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 21-03, two (2) additional judicial Sections, HI 04 and HI 05, were created in the County Civil Division to effectuate the prompt disposition of Summary Procedure (SP) cases; and

WHEREAS, after a review of the SP case filings currently in Sections HI 04 and HI 05, it has been determined that the distribution and assignments of new SP case filings should be suspended in these sections, and all new SP case filings should be filed into the remaining Sections HI 01 in the Hialeah Courthouse in an effort to promote the efficient and prompt administration of such cases; and

WHEREAS, to ensure efficient processing of the SP cases, all currently filed and pending SP cases in Section HI 04 and HI 05 shall remain in their respective sections to be heard by the currently assigned judge.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rule 2.215, Rules of Judicial Administration, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. All new Summary Procedure (SP) case filings in Section HI 04 and HI 05 are hereby suspended, effective May 15, 2021, and the newly filed SP cases after this date shall be filed into the remaining section, HI 01, located in the Hialeah Courthouse.
2. All currently pending SP cases in Sections HI 04 and HI 05 shall remain in their respective sections to be heard by the currently assigned judge.
3. Cases currently in a closed status in HI 04 or HI 05 that are reopened after the signing of this Administrative Order, shall be reassigned by the Administrative Judge.

Except as amended herein, Administrative Order No. 21-03 remains in effect until further order of the court. This Administrative Order shall take effect on May 15, 2021 and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
