WHEREAS, the Supreme Court Rules Advisory Committee, pursuant to Rule 2.050 (e) (3), shall make recommendations to the Supreme Court concerning whether each administrative order falls within the definition of a local court rule as defined in Rule 2.020, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration; and

WHEREAS, all administrative orders of a general and continuing nature which remain in effect are to be submitted to the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Florida on or before April 1, 1979; and

WHEREAS, all administrative orders which are obsolete or which have been superseded and are no longer in force should be purged from the records:

THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, it is

ORDERED as follows:

With the exception of the following numbered administrative orders, all administrative orders entered during the years 1971 through 1979 are declared invalid and hereby rescinded.
