**IN RE: CREATION OF SECTION CC 03
AND REDISTRIBUTION OF CASES IN
THE COUNTY CIVIL DIVISION OF THE
ELEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF
FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, the Court has determined that it is necessary to establish one additional judicial section to accommodate the increase in new case filings and address the inequities in judicial workload across the County Civil Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rule 2.215 of the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Section CC 03 is established in the County Civil Division in the Dade County Courthouse, location 05.
2. The Clerk of Courts shall take the following actions to achieve equity in the distribution of cases in the County Civil Division of the Court:
 - a. The Clerk of Courts shall make a one-time transfer of Personal Injury Protection Cases, both County Court (CC) and Summary Procedure (SP). Specifically, the 2,500 oldest cases filed on or after January 1, 2019, identified in the existing caseload from judicial section (SD05) at the South Dade Justice Center, location (23). These selected cases shall be reassigned as follows:
 - 2,500 cases to Judicial Section CC 03 in the Dade County Courthouse.
 - b. Thereafter, judicial Section CC 03 shall be included in the blind-filing configuration for distribution and assignment of all County Court (CC) and Summary Procedure (SP) cases filed in the Dade County Courthouse, location (05), in accordance with established blind-filing procedures for assignment and reassignment of cases.

This Order shall take effect immediately upon signing and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
